



## **Canadian Forestry Accreditation Board Bureau canadien d'agrément en foresterie**

### **Accreditation and Related Activity**

#### **Accreditation Review of the Forest Management Program, School of Forestry, University of Moncton**

Following consideration of the report of the accreditation review team and related documentation, the Canadian Forestry Accreditation Board has determined that accreditation of the Forest Management Program, School of Forestry, University of Moncton, shall be granted for a period of six years. The accreditation period begins with the 2016/17 academic year and continues to June 30, 2022, or for as long as the subject program is in place, whichever is of shorter duration. The determination is subject to all relevant provisions of the CFAB Policy Statement which declares that, among others, "the term of the accreditation is subject to review for cause at any time".

In making its decision, the Board determined that the program, as reviewed, meets fully the requirements for accreditation established by the CFAB Policy Statement and the requirements of the *Academic standards for the accreditation of degree forestry programs in Canada*. [October 2016]

The accreditation review of the School's Forest Management Program was conducted March 16-18, as scheduled. The final review report is scheduled to be received from the team by mid-July. [April 2016]

#### **Accreditation Review of the Forestry and Forest Business Management Programs, Faculty of Agriculture, Environmental and Life Sciences, University of Alberta**

In correspondence with the Dean, Faculty of Agriculture, Life and Environmental Sciences and the Faculty's Chair, Department of Renewable Resources, it has been agreed that an accreditation review of the University of Alberta's Forestry and Forest Business Management Programs will be conducted March 29-31, 2017.

The current accreditations of the programs expire June 30, 2017. [August 2016]

**Accreditation Review of the Forest Ecosystem Management Program, Faculty of Forestry and Environmental Management, University of New Brunswick**

In correspondence with the Dean, Faculty of Forestry and Environmental Management, it has been agreed that an accreditation review of the University of New Brunswick's Forest Ecosystem Management Program will be conducted March 22-24, 2017.

The current accreditations of the programs expire June 30, 2017. [July 2016]
